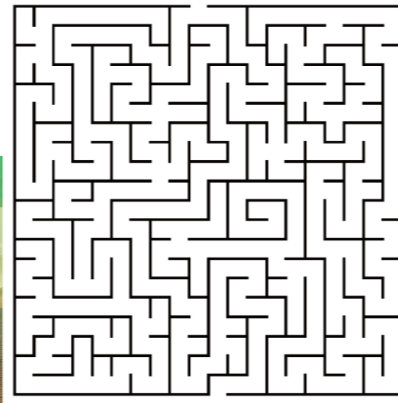

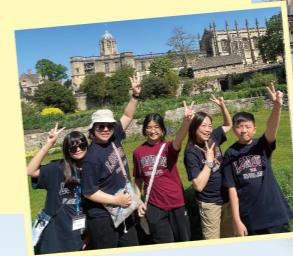

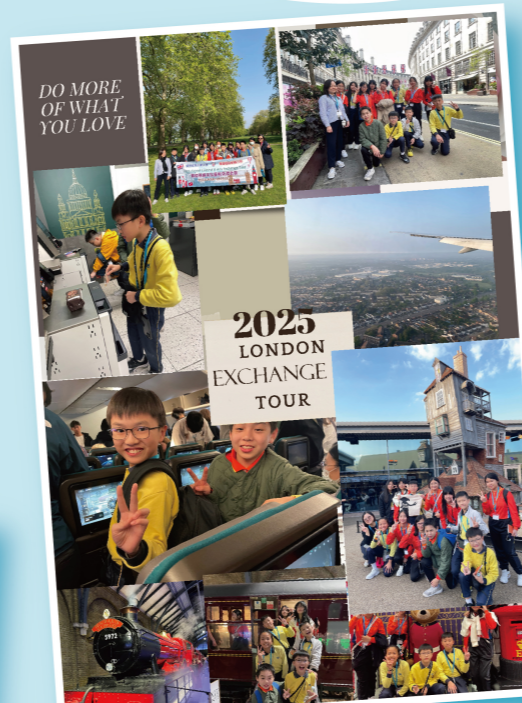
29th April, 2025 - A Sunny Day in Oxford!
